## CALL FOR PAPERS

International Conference on RFID Security-07 is the third of the successful "Workshop on RFID Sec" held in Graz (Austria) in the last two years organized by the IAIK and ECRYPT. These conferences represent a reference point for experts and researchers in the RFID Security field.

RFID technology is one of the most promising technologies in the world today. Its reduced cost defines a huge area of potential applications.
